

## Leading in Partnership Programme

The Leading in Partnership programme aims to develop the necessary leadership skills to ensure health and social care professionals and service users and carers can work more collaboratively to enhance the principles of Involvement and Collective Leadership.



### Module 1: Leading from Within

**Thursday  
18 Sept**

Focuses on introductions to the course, discussion about the 'leadership versus management' debate, review of influential leaders in the world. There will also be a focus on our own leadership lifelines and the different leadership styles we adopt in certain scenarios.

### Module 2: Leading to Influence

**Wednesday  
1 October**

Focuses on Quality Improvement & Innovation using trauma informed values, principles and theories combined with lived experience, to bring to life and humanise learning and change.

### Module 3: Leading to Listen and Understand

**Tuesday  
28 October**

Using personal stories and experiences this module focuses on communication styles and levels of listening and how these can be applied.

### Module 4: Leading Collectively

**Wednesday  
12 November**

Focuses on what collective leadership looks like in practice, what strategies on collective leadership tell us, how values play a role in leading, we also look at what we mean by 'team working' and the variation in team roles.

### Module 5: Leadership Power and Politics

**Tuesday  
25 November**

Examines Theory, Research and Evidence, focusing on the theoretical and political fields associated with Involvement. Discuss evidence informed research and apply the learning to evidence case study design and implementation.
